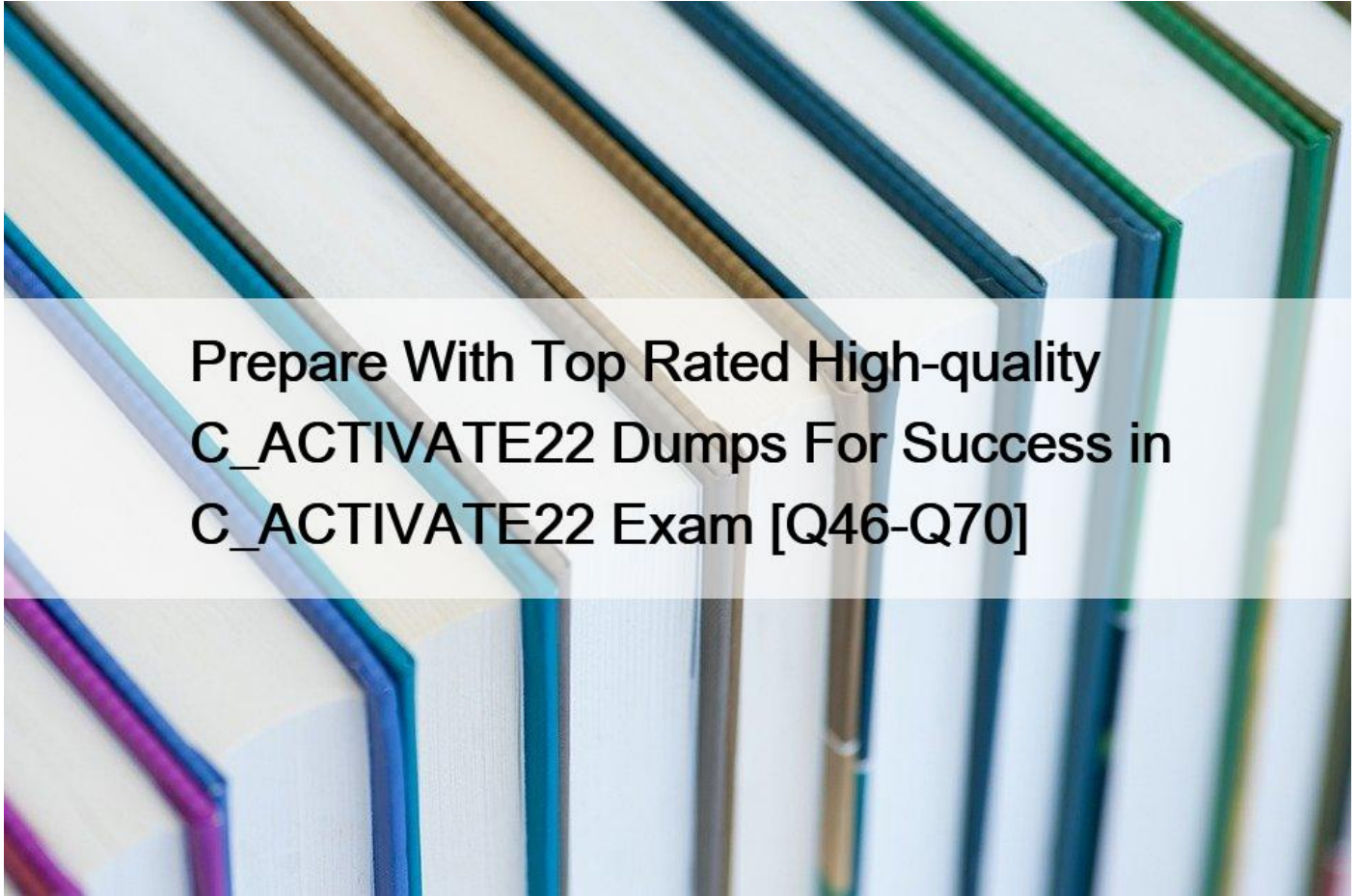

C is correct because upgrades of SAP S/4HANA Cloud, public edition are based on SAP timelines, and upgrades of SAP S/4HANA Cloud, private edition are based on timelines agreed between SAP and the customer. This is one of the differences between the two transition paths. SAP S/4HANA Cloud, public edition has mandatory quarterly upgrades that are performed by SAP, while SAP S/4HANA Cloud, private edition has optional upgrades that are scheduled by the customer in coordination with SAP.

D is correct because SAP S/4HANA Cloud, private edition uses the Implementation Guide (IMG) and SAP S/4HANA Cloud, public edition uses SAP Central Business Configuration. This is another difference between the two transition paths. SAP S/4HANA Cloud, private edition allows more flexibility and customization in the configuration, while SAP S/4HANA Cloud, public edition follows a guided and standardized configuration process.
